Nourishment

52,625 total served meals in our soup kitchen and emergency shelter plus evening bagged meals, emergency food orders, soup van dinners, and holiday food orders.

Food pantry – 81,744 bags of groceries (786 families/week)



Stability

36,407 bed nights at our Emergency Shelter and Transitional Housing.

49% of bed nights were occupied by children.

140 men, women, and children called our Emergency Shelter home in 2019.

Comfort

\$367,767 in transactions at our three thrift stores.

\$3,340 in vouchers for free clothing, furniture and other household items.

2,986 advocacy services for single men, women and families.



Dignity

33 English for Speakers of Other Languages students learned English.

37 Work Prep students participated in our Culinary Training Program or trained at Spark*L.E. Cleaning Company.

40 students participated in our Sewing Certification Program.

27 guests received job placement assistance.
